PRE-REGISTRATION

To prepare for your cruise, here is information about your E-DOCUMENTS & LUGGAGE TAGS. To streamline the process, CARNIVAL CRUISE LINE produces "E-Documents." Carnival requires that passengers complete an on-line registration. On-Line is the only way this information can be provided to Carnival. It is suggested that those without a computer & printer ask for assistance from a friend or relative. Carnival allows Pre Registration to begin two weeks (14 days) prior to your sailing date. Platinum & Diamond guests may begin their Pre Registration process an additional two days prior to that day (total of 16 days in advance of sailing date) As check in times are strictly adhered to, completing the registration process early will ensure you receive a desirable check in time.

For On-Line Registration, please follow these easy directions:

LOG ON: www.carnival.com If you've not already visited this site and created a user name and password you will need to do this. Assistance is available, if needed, using the phone number listed on the site. (1-800-764-7419) From the "MANAGE" tab on the menu bar, select the "My Booking" option. You will need your booking number which can be found on your name label on your document wallet or on prior invoice/confirmation statements. If you have a "0" in your booking number this is a ZERO (not the letter O) You'll need your Passport (if using one) and a credit card to supply these details in the appropriate sections.

OPEN THE "MY PLANNER" OPTION. This includes several important elements to be completed prior to departure such as: registration of your personal details, emergency contact, travel plans, credit card account for onboard expenses. You can shop for and book shore excursions, spa services, gifts & services as well as Beverage Packages (alcohol & soft drinks). You really can't make a mistake as all the requested information is about YOU!

Once you have completed the registration process, you are able to print your BOARDING PASSES & CRUISE SUMMARY. Luggage tags are available when you print your e-documents, however, these will be printed on your paper stock (which will not hold up during the rigors of traveling!) You can strengthen the tags by "laminating" them using clear packing tape available at many stores. The idea is to completely cover your tags with tape so that they are sturdy enough to wrap around your luggage handles. Many travelers purchase inexpensive plastic or clear vinyl tag holders that are readily available on-line at travel accessory websites or even Amazon. You'll want to print your Boarding Passes, Cruise Summary, Baggage Tags and any other documents listed in the Planner that you feel you will want.

It's recommended that you attach your ship luggage tags before you leave home. Although your vacation may start earlier than the actual sailing date, you'll still want your cruise ship tags to be securely attached to your luggage. In the unlikely event that your bags go astray, having the cruise ship tag on them will assist the airlines or Port personnel in getting you reunited with your luggage. You can always print extra tags to have on hand just in case the original ones become tattered or otherwise compromised during travel and transit.

Note: when filling out the "travel plans" section, you will be asked for airline info or driving details (taxi, rental car, personal car, etc) YOU ONLY NEED TO FILL IN AIRLINE DETAILS IF FLYING ON DAY OF SAILING OR DAY THE CRUISE ENDS!! If you are staying at a hotel, with friends or any other accommodation, you DO NOT need to provide your arrival air information!!! Carnival ONLY needs arrival details in order to account for passengers if there are airline related delays on day of sailing!!!
